Moppa for Poppa... Here's an old fashioned Barossa dry red which your poppa would love with a roast over Christmas. The Kalleske Moppa Barossa Valley Shiraz 2007 celebrates the establishment of Prussian emigrants the Kalleske family's farm and vineyard at Moppa, a tiny sub-district of Greenock, in the valley's north west. The Moppa public school on the vineyard property educated the Kalleskes and others in the area from 1873 until 1935, when it closed. A luscious big wine, the Moppa Shiraz is enhanced with a small amount of viognier and petit verdot, which "gives it a contemporary edge", says winemaker Troy Kalleske, A 100% certified organic wine.

Dark red black colour shows the youth, intensity and class of this wine from first glance. The nose just confirms that, a melange of dark fruits, berries, plums, spices with just a touch of vanilla all mingled in together, and along that are some intriguing touches of dried herbs, pepper and mulberries and sandalwood.

Just delightful. The palate follows through wonderfully, incredibly tasty and well made, chock full of cranberry, raspberry hinted fruits, with an exotic touch. Its long, its intense but balanced, its structured, its ripe but its subtle, in short, its just a classic Barossa Shiraz, with the class of the fruit and wine making of Kalleske wines shining through!

Opaque black crimson colour with black crimson hue. Perfumed nose with violet top note, followed by blackberry and spice.


