2016 KALLESKE FORDSON ZINFANDEL

94 Points

Did somebody say Zinfandel?! If you've never tried one, this is a great place to start. Straight up you notice the luscious dark red colour with an impenetrable core.

The aroma is full on! It has all the depth and intensity of a full bodied Cabernet. Thinking musically, the aroma has a base note of dark fruits, mid note of spearmint and a top note like musk.

In the mouth it's a mid to full bodied red. Layers of dark and red fruits from strawberry at the top, to blueberry, quince, guava right down to dark satsuma plums can be found. There's sweet licorice, caramel, sarsaparilla, pepper and star anise in here too. The latter two sparkle right down the length of the finish. They are kept on their dancing toes by a dusting of tannins helped minimally by the oak.

Although the 2016 Fordson by Kalleske is full of fruit, it remains sleek and youthful. It will benefit from being in the cellar short term and probably be at it's peak in about 5 years.
