If you didn't know better you'd be forgiven for thinking some quirky new super-premium had just landed. The cool 2011 vintage has birthed a particularly savoury and spicy grenache shiraz mataro blend, accented with fresh rhubarb, pepper, bay leaf and berry fruits. Fine, savoury tannins promise a longer life in the cellar than usual, making for a particularly sophisticated Clarry's".
