



2018 KALLESKE FORDSON ZINFANDEL

"Seldom seen in Australia, Zin has the capacity for ripeness and power albeit, the disparate nature of ripening within grape clusters ensures a sweet : sour freshness. Well suited to the vanillas of American oak, this is a suave operator. satsuma plum, raspberry, candied orange zest, bramble and peppery, herbal tannins assuage the richness of the wine. The oak, too, helps corral the billowing flavours. Delicious! A fine example, best on the cool side."

"Deep red colour with a tint of purple. The bouquet is smoky, blackberry, bitumen and graphite. The palate adds blackberry conserve, is full-bodied and supple, with richness, density and soft fleshy tannins. A whopper."

"Barossa zinfandel weighing in at only 13.5% alc. You'd not guess the alcohol from the wine's flavour profile. It's sweet and jammy but then it's also fresh and there is zero heat on the finish. Indeed there's as much boysenberry and raspberry as there is plum jam. There's a spiciness, almost a twigginess at play here too. It's an interesting example of the variety."
