It's a charming rendition of Barossa Shiraz offering perfume, red and black fruit, and nutty nougat oak in support. Juicy and saline, fine grained tannin, plenty of flavour and plushness to fruit, even weight and a finish that's pretty good, but falls short of the expectation that's set by that which comes before it. That being said, I think it will settle and grow with a few more years on it."
