Bright purple colour with red edges. Aromatics are imposing: ripe plums, coconut oak, some raisining - old school. More freshness on the palate. A burst of sweet, ripe plums tailing into brighter raspberry acidity on the finish. It benefits from time open - air softening the wine and liberating its fruit. Cellaring recommended."
