It's from Moppa y'see, with wisps of petit verdot (7%) and viognier (2%) and matured in French, American and Hungarian oak (25% new) for 13 months. There is that deep northern bassline of vibrant plum and dark berry fruits cut with baking spices, chocolate bullets, dried herbs, vanilla and light violet tones. Velvety smooth with gypsum-dust tannins and a supple, plushly fruited finish dusted with spice and earth"*
