"Deep crimson. Lifted dark cherry, blackberry, boysenberry, touchstone fruit aromas. Generously concentrated palate with saturated dark berry fruits, dark chocolate, vanilla, hint ginger/apricot flavours, fine loose-knit chocolaty tannins, superb mid-palate viscosity and well integrated acidity. Finishes velvety, minerally and dry. Now-2030"

"Shiraz sourced from Moppa in the northwest of the Barossa Valley with a little bit of petit verdot (6%) and viognier (4%), matured for 13 months in 20% new French, American and Hungarian oak. Super deep colour with notes of violets and frangipani fluttering over the deep plum, boysenberry and blueberry fruits. Spice-packed with notes of wood spice, fruit cake and licorice, it has impressive fruit density and depth, fine tannins and a blast of blueberry, macerated plums and spice on the exit."
